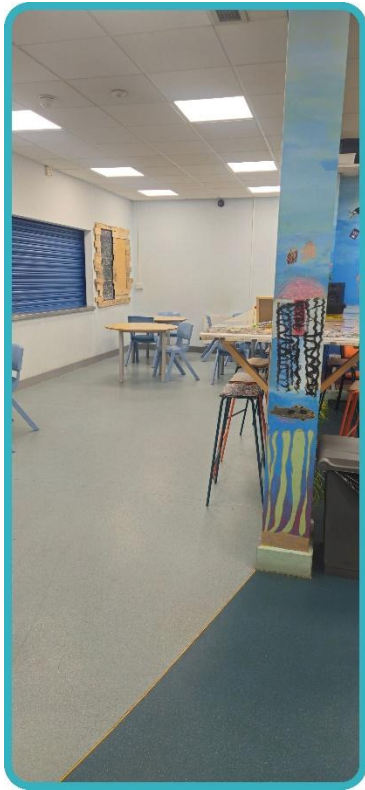
Preparation
