### **Organisation & Challenge details**

Fab2 is a project based inside the Shipley Resource Centre, run by the organisation New Choices. The project supports those with learning difficulties and aims to help them build the skills to live independently.

### **Project Details**

They have a large, open, outdoor space, however it is lacking functionality. Your task will be:

- Repair and replace decking
- Build 2x disabled access raised beds

### **Volunteer Number**

We are looking for a team of up-to 10 volunteers

### **On-site support**

On the day Participate will be providing a member of staff to support the volunteers. A trained first aider and first aid kit will be available during the challenge. A 'Tools Talk' and health and safety briefing will be given by Participate at the beginning of the day.

### **Preparation**

This is a relatively low risk challenge and where personal protective equipment is required it will be provided. This will include latex free gloves to protect rings etc when painting. Please be, you will get this on your clothing and will not wash out. This is why we recommend wearing clothing you don't mind spoiling.

Volunteers will be working externally must wear old and reasonably robust clothing. Volunteers should pay particular attention to footwear wearing tough shoes or boots. Do not wear Crocs or open toe shoes such as sandals or flip flops. Finally, volunteers should prepare for the weather.
